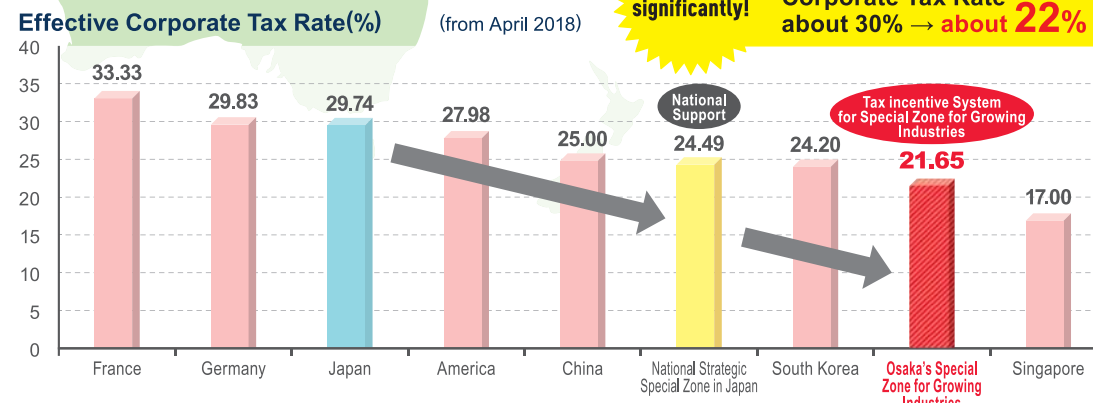

Comparing Effective Corporation Tax Rates

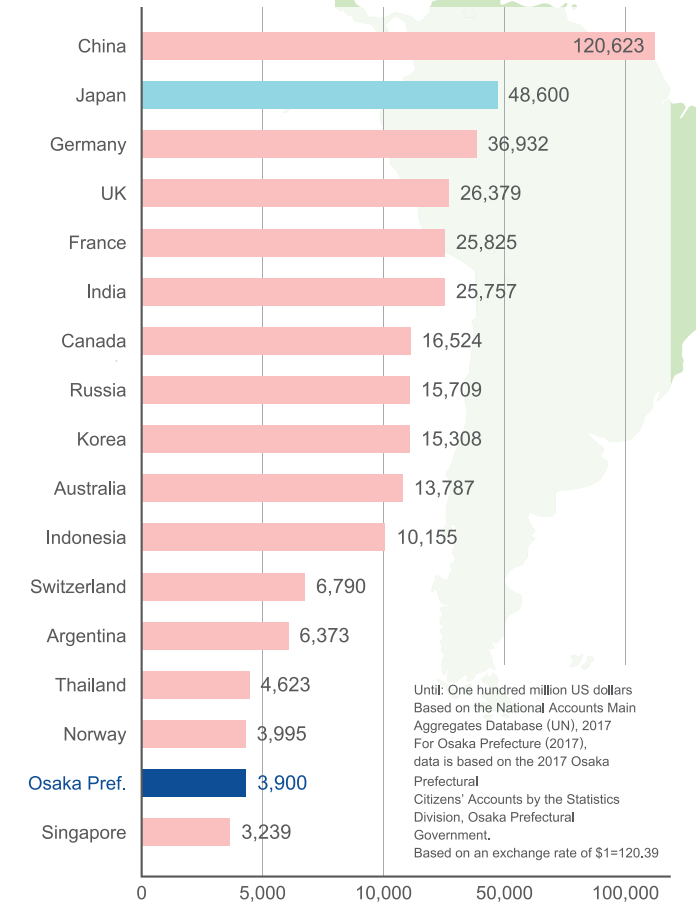
Through efficient use of the national tax incentives and Osaka's Special Zone for Growing Industries Tax Incentive System, Japan's relatively "high" effective corporate tax rate is reduced to the low rates found in East Asian nations!



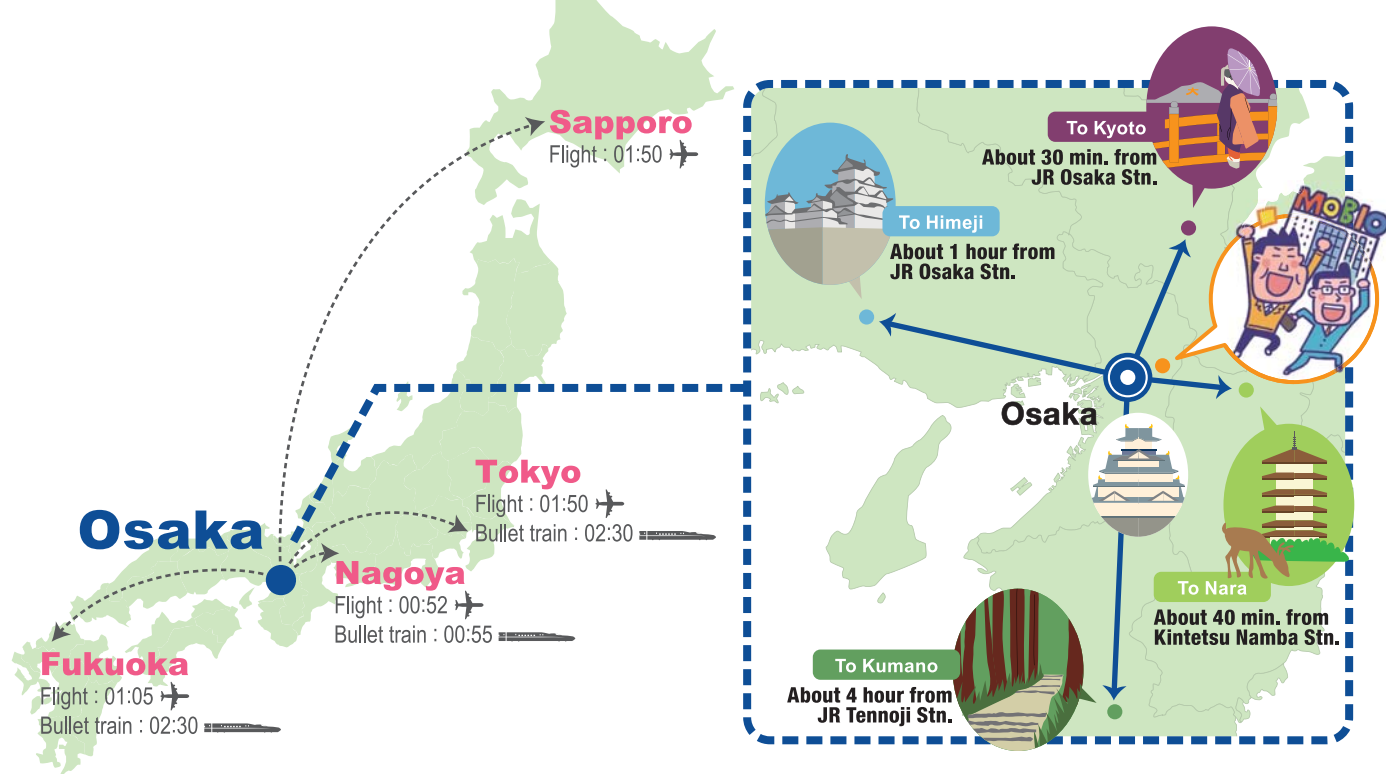

World-renowned things originated in Osaka



Osaka has long been known as a merchant town.

To date, many companies in Osaka have produced the world's first core products and services. Typical examples are as follows.

Timeline	Episode
Instant noodle	1958, Momofuku Ando invested the world's first instant noodles, "Chicken Ramen," he founded NISSIN FOOD PRODUCTS CO., LTD. It was "CUP NOODLES" launched in 1971 that became the world first instant noodle with a cup.
Conveyor belt sushi	"Liaoning Genroku Sushi first store" of 1958 (1958) Genroku industry, which opened in Fuse, Higashi Osaka City in April (Ltd.) is the world's first of conveyor belt sushi.
Prefabricated house	The origin of prefabricated house is "Midget house" which Daiwa House Industry Co., Ltd. launched as a study room in 1959.
Retort food	In 1958, Otsuka Foods Co., Ltd. launched "Bon Curry" using the sterilization technology of drip solutions from a group company. That is the roots of retort foods.
Automatic ticket gate	The world's first automatic ticket gate was installed at Kita Senri station on the Hankyu Senri line by OMRON Corporation in 1967.
Futures trading markets	In 1730, the Shogunate publicly allowed the "Bookkeeping Rice Trading," a kind of futures transaction conducted on the books as a measure to raise rice prices in the Dojima rice market.
